Faculty Dress Code (Handbook)-

Female Faculty and Staff are expected to dress in a modest and professional fashion. Styles that are casual or fad-driven are not considered professional. Clothing must be modest and of appropriate fit and length. Skirts and dresses should be at or below the knee. Upscale material crop pants with length at the ankle or right above the ankle are appropriate. Professional dress does not include jeans or denim clothing, leggings, casual pants, faded or wrinkled clothing, skorts, shorts, T-shirts, tank tops, or warm-ups. Appropriate shoes must be worn with professional attire. Tennis shoes, casual sandals, or crocs may not be worn. No faculty or staff member may have a visible tattoo.

Male faculty and staff members should be clean shaven with neatly trimmed beards. Acceptable dress includes collared shirt or dress shirt tucked in, slacks, socks, and dress shoes.
