Tuition rates are based on the religious affiliation of the student and the identified financial steward status of the parents/guardians.

- **Catholic – Identified Financial Steward (IFS)** is for registered parishioners of St. George Parish who meet the minimum donation to the offertory collection, totaling no less than \$300 per calendar year. A donation to St. George School is not considered for IFS status.
- **Catholic – Non-Identified Financial Steward (NIFS)** rate applies to all other Catholic families who are not identified as financial stewards as deemed by St. George Parish and/or who are members of other parishes.
- **Non-Catholic (NC)** tuition rate applies to families with students who are not baptized in the Catholic faith.

Fees

- **Enrollment Fee** of \$125 is due at time of enrollment. This fee is non-refundable.
- **Student Fee** is a per student fee of \$250 to cover textbooks, H&S dues and student accident insurance.
- **Technology Fee** is a per student fee of \$150 to cover technology costs, including but not limited to student hardware, online textbook licenses, student software, and FACTS.
- **Building fee** is a per family fee of \$200 and is used for capital improvement projects across campus.
- **Security Fee** is a per student fee of \$50 to cover 11 hour per day deputy presence and campus wide security systems and devices.
- **Supply Fee** is a per student fee (PK – 1st grade only) of \$100 and is used to cover supplies used throughout the year. This fee is paid in lieu of parents ordering school supplies.

Payment Plans

1. **FACTS** is used for tuition management. Four payment plans are available.
 - Annual payment due May 1st
 - Semi-annual payments due May 1st and November 1st
 - Quarterly payments due May 1st, August 1st, November 1st, and February 1st
 - Monthly payments from July through April

Withdrawals

If a student withdraws from school, a refund is issued based on the prorated number of days attended by the student. **If a student withdraws after July 31st, fees are non-refundable.**
