LA GATOR: Education Savings Account

ACE:

Applications for new and returning students will open Monday, February 3, 2025 and close on TAX DAY (April 15, 2025) at 11:59 p.m. in the time zone of the school. See the website for details eligibilty requirements, applications and other information. acescholarships.org

Arete:

Applications will open on February 25 at 9:00 a.m. See the website for details, eligibility, applications and other information. Aretescholars.org

Diocesan Assistance:

There are several sources of funding available from the Diocese of Baton Rouge. Applications for the funds listed below are made through FACTS. Assistance is awarded on the basis of need. Students in elementary grades cannot receive diocesan assistance if they receive assistance from any of the sources listed above. Bishop's Annual Appeal:

A portion of donations to the Bishop's Annual Appeal are allocated for financial assistance. Returning recipients are funded first and new awards are made with remaining funds.

Black and Indian Mission Fund:

Black students and certified American Indian students are eligible to apply for these funds.
