

## PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT

### ST. GEORGE ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION

St. George Athletic Association provides athletic opportunities for the students of St. George School. In order to provide a positive environment for participating student and their families, all parents are expected to comply with the following Code of Conduct.

1. I will inform the coach of any disability that may affect the safety of my child or the safety of others.
2. I will learn the rules of the game and teach my child to play by the rules.
3. I will encourage sportsmanship from my child by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials and spectators at every game, practice or other sporting event.
4. I will respect officials and their authority during the game.
5. I will not engage in any unsportsmanlike conduct with any player, coach, official or parent. I understand that coaches, officials, or league representatives can require me to leave a game or practice for demonstrating unsportsmanlike behavior.
6. I will not ridicule or berate my child, or any other participant, for making a mistake, playing poorly or losing a competition. I will support the efforts of my child more than the results.
7. I will remember that coaches, coordinators and league officials are volunteers. I will never question, discuss or confront coaches during a game. I will address my concerns to them in an appropriate manner, away from my child and other participants.
8. I will ensure that my child will attend all practices and games when possible, and when my child cannot attend, I will inform the coach in advance.
9. I will be prompt in picking up my child from practices and games, or I will verify that someone has responsibility for my child before leaving the child at a practice or game.
10. I will demand a sports environment that is free from drugs, tobacco and alcohol, and will refrain from their use at all sporting events.
