- 1) Developing and implementing effective lesson plans reflecting curriculum goals
 - Develop daily lesson plans that reflect the needs of all students
 - Plan for instruction with logically sequenced objectives based on adopted curriculum
 - Utilize varied assessment tools to perform both formative and summative assessments
 - Identify students whose needs are not being met and create a plan of action for those students
- 2) Providing rigorous and engaging methods of learning through a variety of educational techniques
 - Use effective instructional methods and models according to professional standard practice
 - Utilize appropriate material and resources for students to engage in learning
 - Organize materials and workspaces required for daily instruction and activities
 - Integrate the use of technology within the curriculum
 - Strive to develop talents and abilities of all students through a variety of measures
- 3) Implementing total classroom management, including effective parent communication
 - Provide a safe, clean and organized classroom environment

- Ensure students' safety outside of the classroom
- Provide positive, consistent discipline so students work effectively in the classroom
- Establish routines and provide positive guidance
- Encourage and monitor social interaction among the students
- Model appropriate conflict resolution to the students
- Maintain current and accurate records according to school policies
- Communicate with parents regarding academic, behavioral, and safety concerns
